Advocacy Tool to identify research gaps in Europe. Identify areas with **research gaps** in Europe, to decide on specific actions.

3.2 EFORT Endorsed Research Project

EFORT support to O&T submissions of research projects (letter of support, listing). Foster the consortium constitution and provide a window of dissemination and helps to locate O&T research projects across Europe. An EFORT approved endorsement of third party research projects. Application available on <https://www.efort.org/education-and-courses/endorsed-projects/>.

3.3 Education Advisory Board

AIM: to keep on file individuals that might be interested in contributing to EFORT. They could be "dormant" (no benefits, no specific activities) until required; avoid enlarging groups; allows EFORT to have a legal file (submitted forms) of people motivated and interested in contributing to EFORT, access to specific speakers or organizers when needed. Avoids missing significant volunteers due to relying on personal networks.

OBJECTIVE: To build a bank of surgeons (Education Advisory Board) across Europe with interest in O&T education and further develop initiatives. Request each National Societies to provide maximum of 5 names only. Once accepted a certificate would be provided to acknowledge Membership of EFORT Education Advisory Board.

3.4 Webinar development

To date 7 Webinars developed through EduCom Working groups (OEG & BRG) and in collaboration with specialty societies (SOFOT, SECEC, etc.) have taken place. To date a large interest from orthopaedic community (registration and live participation) Replay available after live webinars on EFORT Website thus providing availability of continuous education. Webinars are free of charge consider in future to charge. Little funding available for webinars may wish to consider funding in future. Webinars are broadcast live from faculty hospital or home location and Replays are available after. Development of further sponsorship is required.

Action: Future webinars being organised by Education working groups over next 18 months. Suggestions to involve members (associate, international) from around the world on hot topics. Other areas of webinars developments to be set up i.e. CME, charging participants, topics UEMS guidelines?

4. Education Committee Group Updates

4.1 Basic Research Group (BRG) meet by telco once a month.

Basic Science and Research on line course, launched Vienna 2017, now in progress of being relaunched by shortening the lectures to 10 minutes, add new topics and applying for CME credits. Organised and now developing future webinars. Provide articles to OTE newsletter.

4.2 Orthopaedics Education Group (OEG) meet by zoom call once a month.

OEG launched in March 2018. Group of 10 members covering all topics of orthopaedics. Successful organisation of 3 remote Webinars (November 2018,



<p>April & May 2019) with live attendance. Planning future ones for 2019/2020. Providing scientific support to annual FORTE summer school in July in Milan. EFORT Board represented and supported. Action: waiting for final programme. 2020 Summer School 8-12 July (Greece or Poland TBC). Programme reviewed and approved request for one EFORT Board member to be sponsored at future summer schools.</p> <p>4.3 Trauma Education Group (TEG) face to face meeting once a year. Monthly zoom calls to begin in Summer. Group set up in 2010. This year the group has been restructured with new members replacing Norbert Haas and Florian Gebhard have been introduced; Thierry Bégué, Enrique Guerado and Peter Biberthaler. Future concept and replacements will take place over the next years. Future ExMEx discussed and will now be postponed to 2020. Action decide date, place and faculty and organisation. Confirm Autumn ExMEx in Lugano area. Evaluate if possible to include TEG surveys in White Book. MoU between AO and EFORT signed. Future collaboration with EFORT and ESTES in form of MoU in progress (each to have slot at each other's congress). New task for group to submit Guest Editorials once a year in OTE. EOTEP: Further investigate with AO possibility of incorporating AO event links on EOTEP. Discuss innovative courses and future webinars.</p>

New area on EOTEP – 'university category' includes ESTRO: https://www.efort.org/eotep-roadmap/ click on University Programmes has been added. <p>6. EBOT – UEMS/EFORT</p> <p>New entity EFORT-UEMS to manage O&T assessment across Europe. Board made up of 3 members EFORT and 3 members UEMS. Representative on EFORT Board Nanni Allington.</p> <p>New statutes approved. Budget of EBOT related activities under: written exam, including preparation (MCQs), management and delivery of MCQ exams: Interim exam, Final exam, Oral exam and National exams (under new agreement). Agreement with National Societies SECOT (3 years of EBOT-ES) and others under discussion (France, Belgium, Austria).</p> <p>Oral exam will be in Manchester, England in October this year to promote the exam in the UK.</p>
